COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 322, L. D. 1084, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Water and Air Environmental Improvement Commission."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1, R. S., T. 38, §361, amended. The first paragraph of section 361 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

The water and Air Environmental Improvement Commission, as heretofore established and hereinafter in this subchapter called the "commission," shall consist of the-Commissioner-of-Health-and Welfare-who-shall-serve-during-his-term-of-office-and 10 members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council, 2-of-whom-shall-represent-manufacturing-interests-of-the-State,-2-of-whom-shall-be-representatives-of-municipalities,-2-of-whom-shall represent-the-public-generally,-2-of-whom-shall-represent-the-con-servation-interests-in-the-State-and-2-other-members-knowledgeablein-matters-relating-to-air-pellution. The membership of the commission shall reflect the conservation, manufacturing, municipal and public interests of the State. The members appointed by the Governor shall be appointed for a term of 3 years and until their successors are appointed and duly qualified.'

Further amend said Bill in section 9 by inserting after the underlined word "Any" in the 4th line (same in L.D.) the underlined

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word '<u>significant</u>' and by inserting after the underlined words "<u>increase in"</u> the underlined words '<u>daily average</u>'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "<u>§414</u>" of section 10 by inserting after the underlined word "<u>such</u>" in the 2nd line of subsection 3 (same in L. D.) the underlined word

Further amend said Bill in that part designated <u>"§414</u>" of section 10 by inserting in the next to the last line of subsection 3, after the underlined words "<u>may make</u>" the underlined word 'reasonable'
