

STATE OF MAINE SENATE 104th LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 324, L.D. 1086, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize the Portland Water District to Engage in Sewer Collection and Treatment to Protect the Purity of Sebago Lake."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by adding at the end of the first sentence, before the period, (same in L.D. 1086) the following words and punctuation 'provided, however, that in disposing of any treated effluent into the Presumpscot River, said district shall discharge said effluent into said river at any point below North Gorham Dam, so called'; and by striking out in the next to the last line (last line in L.D.) the words "municipal officers" and inserting in place thereof the word 'inhabitants'

Further amend said Bill in section 5 by striking out in the 10th line (8th line of L.D.) the words "land or"

Further amend said Bill in section 12 by striking out all of the next to the last sentence of the first paragraph (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following: 'Said bonds or notes shall be issued to mature serially, in annual installments, the first of which shall be payable not later than 5 years from the date of such bonds or notes and the last of which shall be payable not later than 40 years from said date, as the trustees shall determine; or may be issued for a term of years not exceeding 40 years; or in a combination to mature serially and for a term of years not exceeding 40 years, all as the trustees shall determine. Said bonds may be callable with or without premium.'

Further amend said Bill in section 12 by striking out all of the last sentence of the 2nd paragraph (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following: 'The time within which such temporary notes shall be payable need not be included in determining the period for which said bonds or notes may be issued.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end, a new section, as follows: (same in L.D.)

<u>'Sec. 21. Rights conferred subject to provisions of</u> <u>law; Public Utilities Commission supervision.</u> All the rights and duties herein mentioned shll be exercised and performed in accordance with all the provisions of the Revised Statutes of 1964, Title 35, and all Acts amendatory thereof and additional thereto.'
