## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT to Provide Free of Charge Hearing Aids to Those Persons Earning
Less than Four Thousand Dollars Annually.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Hearing aids. Every person residing in Maine who earns less than \$4,000 annually shall be furnished a hearing aid free of charge by the Department of Health and Welfare.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act the sum of \$532,000. This appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuous carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.
