HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 857, L. D. 1099, Bill,
"AN ACT Providing for Adequate Fishways in Dams and Other Obstructions."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'AN ACT Providing for a Fishway in the Dam Across the
Kennebec River at Augusta.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Fishway. The dam across the Kennebec River at Augusta
shall be provided by the owners or occupants of such dam with a
durable and efficient fishway in accordance with specifications
promulgated by the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game.
The Department of Inland Fisheries and Game shall supervise and
operate the fishway and shall prevent the passage of all fish,
except anadromous fish, during the spawning season of such anadromous
fish.'

If such fishway is not constructed within 2 years from the
effective date of this Act, it shall be constructed under the
Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 2201.'
