# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Permitting Sunday Hunting of Small Game and Birds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2454, amended. Section 2454 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

## § 2454. Hunting on Sunday

It shall be unlawful to hunt **deer and bear** on Sunday, and possession of firearms in the fields and forests or on the waters or ice of this State on Sunday shall be prima facie evidence of such hunting unless such firearm is carried, securely wrapped in a complete cover, fastened in a case or carried in at least 2 separate pieces in such a manner that it cannot be fired unless the separate pieces are joined together again. For the purpose of this section a clip, magazine or cylinder of a firearm shall not be considered a piece of such firearm.

It shall be lawful to hunt small game and wild birds on Sunday.
