IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Relating to Retirement Allowance for Hal G. Hoyt of Augusta.

Hal G. Hoyt; retirement allowance. Resolved: That the retirement allowance being paid to Hal G. Hoyt be changed from the optional allowance he is receiving to that amount that would have been available had he selected full benefits at the time he had retired on January 1, 1965, including such adjustments as have been granted under Title 5, section 1128, to be paid from the funds of the Maine State Retirement System.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On January 1, 1965 Mr. Hoyt retired, after having served the State for approximately 35 years as Director of the Securities Division of the State Banking Department.

In making application for his pension, he selected Option No. 3, which made provisions for Mrs. Hoyt, in the event of his death. However, Mrs. Hoyt was stricken on January 20th, and admitted to the Maine Medical Center, where she passed away on February 7, 1965.
