AN ACT Relating to Costs of Insurance Premium of State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 285, sub-§ 4, repealed and replaced. Subsection 4 of section 285 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 543 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

4. Payroll deduction. The cost of insurance shall be paid by the State of Maine, except that portion of the premium which is for the benefit of the employee's spouse or children. This amount shall be withheld by payroll deduction and the manner in which deduction shall be made shall be determined by the board of trustees.
