AN ACT Allocating 25% of Sales Tax Collected in City of Saco.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 36, § 1766, additional. Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1766, to read as follows :

§ 1766. Allocation to City of Saco

Twenty-five per cent of the sales and use taxes under this part collected in the City of Saco shall be allocated to the City of Saco for support of the public school system in said city.
