**AN ACT Relating to Bond for Excise Tax for Malt Liquor Sold by
Wholesalers.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 652, amended. The 3rd sentence of the last paragraph of section 652 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Said bond shall be equal to ~~double~~ the highest monthly excise tax paid by the wholesale licensee during the period of his prior calendar year license.
