HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 878, L. D. 1121, Resolve,  
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Providing for Valuation  
of Certain Lands at Current Use.

Amend said Resolve in that part designated "Section 8" by  
striking out in the 9th line (7th and 8th lines in L.D.) the  
underlined words "wherever situated"

Further amend said Resolve in that part designated "Section 8"  
by striking out all of subsection 3 and inserting in place thereof  
the following (same in L.D.):

'3. Lands used for game management or wildlife sanctuaries,  
providing that the municipality in which such real estate is located  
affirmatively approves such legislation in a municipal election.'
