STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fees of Local Sealers of Weights and Measures.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 10, § 2701, amended. The first paragraph of section 2701 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, as follows:

The municipal officers of any city or town having a duly elected full-time sealer of weights and measures may establish a schedule of fees for testing weights and measures within said city or town, which fees shall not exceed the reasonable cost of such testing, and shall not be less than the fees set forth in this paragraph.
