HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 947, L.D. 1125, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Hunting and Fishing Licenses for Certain Maine
Residents in Armed Forces."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting before the words
"Hunting and Fishing" the word 'Combination'.

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 12, §2601, sub-§10-A, repealed and replaced. Subsection
10-A of section 2601 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted
by chapter 495 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the follow-
ing enacted in place thereof:

10-A. Licenses for Maine residents in Armed Forces. A combina-
tion fishing and hunting license shall be issued upon payment of
\$2,plus the issuing fee, to a Maine resident in the Armed Forces of
the United States who is stationed outside the State of Maine. Such
license will be valid for any and all leaves or furloughs during
the year of issue.'
