STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting and Fishing Licenses for Certain Maine Residents in Armed Forces.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 2601, sub-§ 10-A, amended. Subsection 10-A of section 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chatper 495 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:
- ro-A. Licenses for Maine residents in Armed Forces. A resident fishing or hunting license, or both, shall be issued, upon payment of \$\frac{1}{2}\$ the current cost, plus the issuing fee, to a Maine resident in the Armed Forces of the United States who is stationed outside the State and who is in Maine on leave or furlough, and such license or licenses shall be valid only for the duration of his leave or furlough.
 - Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 1970.
