HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 889, L. D. 1148, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Residence of Write-in Candidates on
Ballots."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end, a new section,
as follows:

'Sec. 3. R. S., T. 21, §922, sub-§3, ¶A, amended.

Paragraph A of subsection 3 of section 922 of Title 21 of the
Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

A. Stickers permitted. A sticker may not be used
to vote for a write-in candidate.'
