AN ACT Relating to Molesting Game Animals by Snowmobiles.

---

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2463-A, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2463-A to read as follows:

§ 2463-A. Use of snowmobile

It shall be unlawful to pursue, drive or molest deer or any game animal by snowmobile or to enter any area known to be a winter yard of such animal with snowmobile without the consent of or in the presence of, a game warden or law enforcement officer.
