STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Reestablishing a Passegeway for Boats Across the Dam on the Kennebec River at Augusta.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Passegeway for boats across dam on Kennebec River reestablished. It shall be incumbent upon the owners or occupants of the dam across the Kennebec River at Augusta to maintain and operate at all reasonable times a passageway for boats up to 25 feet in length through or over the said dam, provided that no compensation shall be demanded or received for passage through or over said dam.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Chapter 96, private and special laws of 1878 provided for a lock at the dam at Augusta. This provision was repealed by chapter 3 of the private and special laws of 1895.
