SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 904, L.D. 1165, Bill, "AN ACT
Providing for State Contribution to the Cooperative Soil Survey."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the
General Fund the sum of \$50,000 to carry out the purposes of this
