COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 907, L. D. 1168, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Lewiston-Auburn Water Pollution Control Authority."

Amend said Bill, in section 4, by striking out everything after the amending clause (same in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The director of the Lewiston Department of Public Works and the superintendent and the president of the Auburn Sewerage District shall be members of the board by virtue of their respective offices and in the event of the termination of their offices on the board of public works or the Auburn Sewerage District they shall continue as members of the board of the authority until their replacements are elected or appointed. If the president of the Auburn Sewerage District trustees should decline to serve or should resign as a member of the board of the authority, he shall select another trustee to replace him for the remainder of his term. Notice of such appointment shall be given in writing by the clerk of the Auburn Sewerage District to the board of the authority. The members of the Lewiston board of public works shall elect one of their number to serve for a 2-year term on the board of the authority and thereafter until his successor takes office. In the event that either the member of the board so selected or the appointee of the

president of the Auburn Sewerage District should cease to be a resident of his respective city, or should die, become incapacitated, or otherwise cease to be a member of the Lewiston board of public works or the Auburn Sewerage District trustees, or if the president of the Auburn Sewerage District should die or become incapacitated while serving on the board of the authority, a successor shall be elected to serve out the remainder of his term by the Lewiston board of public works or the Auburn Sewerage District trustees, as the case may be.

The term of the incumbent chairman of the board of public works as a member of the board of the authority shall expire and his successor shall assume office at the annual meeting of the board to be held in January, 1970. Reasonable notice of the date of the meeting and of the necessity of electing a new member of the board of the authority, who may be the incumbent, shall be given to the board of public works by the secretary or clerk of the authority.
