HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 909, L.D. 1170, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Legislative Ethics."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting  
clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 3, §§6 and 7, additional. Title 3 of the Revised  
Statutes is amended by adding 2 new sections, 6 and 7, to read as  
follows:

§6. Legislator defined

"Legislator" means a member of either house of the Maine State  
Legislature.

§7. Disclosure

Each legislator shall, at the commencement of a regular legis-  
lative session and no later than January 31st, file with the clerk  
or secretary of the house of which he is a member a written report  
of each financial interest, direct or indirect, of a value in excess  
of \$100, of himself, his spouse and his dependents in any activity  
which is subject to the jurisdiction of a regulatory agency of this  
State or any subdivision thereof and shall not be allowed to vote or  
speak in any legislative proceeding unless by way of excuse for the  
same, until he has made satisfaction.'
