RESOLVE, to Reimburse Frederick C. Adams of Steep Falls for Loss of Turkeys by Raccoons.

Frederick C. Adams; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$991.25 to reimburse Frederick C. Adams of Wild Acres Turkey Farm, Steep Falls, for loss of turkeys and damage to turkey brooder house by raccoons.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In June 1968, many turkeys at Mr. Adams' farm were killed by raccoons at a monotary loss of \$616.25 and damage to a brooder house in the amount of \$375.
