RESOLVE, in Favor of Matinicus Isle Plantation.

Matinicus Isle Plantation; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated to Matinicus Isle Plantation from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$6,000 to replace a loss of school subsidy aid caused by the revaluation of Matinicus Isle Plantation.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The recent revaluation of Matinicus Isle Plantation by the State Board of Equalization resulted in a loss of \$6,000 in anticipated school subsidy aid. This loss will have a serious impact on proposed school construction.
