STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Tuition Charges for Students from State Institutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 15, § 2716, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 2716 of Title 15 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapters 9 and 456 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Children committed to the Stevens School recommended by the superintendent as eligible therefor, subject to Title 20, section 859, shall be granted entrance into the secondary school maintained within School Administrative District No. 16, or into the secondary school maintained within the Augusta administrative unit as if the guardian of such child has residence in such unit.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 34, § 864, amended. The last two sentences of section 864 of Title 34 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 72 of chapter 513 of the public laws of 1965 and as amended by section 24 of chapter 391 of the public laws of 1967, are repealed.
