COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 930, L. D. 1191, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide for Discovery Procedures in Workmen's
Compensation Hearings."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 3 (same in
L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'3. Proceedings before Industrial Accident Commission.

In all proceedings before the Industrial Accident Commission, all
forms of discovery available in civil actions in the Superior
Court under the Maine Rules of Civil Procedure, as amended, shall
be available to any of the parties in said proceedings except
that an Industrial Accident Commission Commissioner, rather than
a Superior Court Justice, shall rule on all objections; and an
Industrial Accident Commission Commissioner is empowered to enforce
this subsection in the same manner and to the same extent as a
Superior Court Justice may enforce compliance of the Maine Rules
of Civil Procedure, as amended, with regard to discovery, except
that the commissioner shall not have the power of contempt.'
