STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT to Provide for Discovery Procedures in Workmen's Compensation Hearings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 39, § 93, sub-§ 3, repealed and replaced. Subsection 3 of section 93 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- 3. Depositions and interrogatories. In petitions for award and hearings before the Industrial Accident Commission, depositions and interrogatories may be taken and used in the manner provided by rule for depositions and interrogatories in the Superior Court.
