## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 104th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 943, L. D. 1204, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Retirement of Chief Liquor Inspector."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by adding at the end, before the period the words 'and Members of the Retirement System'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line, after the enacting clause, the abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following section:

- 'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 5, §1121, sub-§11, additional. Section 1121 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 11, to read as follows:
- 11. Members of Retirement System. Notwithstanding anything
  to the contrary any member of the Retirement System who is required
  to resign at an age prior to attainment of age 70 shall be permitted
  to continue such employment until attainment of age 70.
