COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 345, L.D. 1211, Bill, "AN ACT Providing Free Tuition at State Colleges for Students from Low Income Families."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by striking out the words "Free Tuition at State Colleges" and inserting in place thereof the words 'for Scholarship Aid'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2237." of section 1 by striking out in the 3rd line (same in L.D.) the underlined word "resident"

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2238." of section 1 by striking out in the 3rd line (same in L.D.) the underlined word "resident"

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2239." of section 1 by striking out in the 2nd line (same in L.D.) the underlined word "resident"

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2241." of section 1 by striking out all of said section and inserting in place thereof the following (same in L.D.)
'§2241. Schedule

The following schedule shall be used for determining grants:

| <u>Effective Income</u> | <u>Amount of Grant Each Semester</u> |
|-------------------------|--------------------------------------|
| \$ <u>0-5,000</u> | <u>\$100</u> |

Students attending a state supported institution at which the tuition does not exceed \$100 per year shall be limited to a grant of \$100 per year.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2244." of section 1 by striking out in the 5th line (4th and 5th lines of L.D.) the underlined words "in an approved program of special education"
