HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 345, L.D. 1211, Bill, "AN ACT Providing Free Tuition at State Colleges for Students from Low Income Families."

Amend said Bill in that part of section 1 designated "§ 2240" by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Effective income of the eligible student and his parents shall include the total income subject to federal income tax, plus interest from governmental obligations, for the prior calendar year of both the student and his parents pursuant to the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 of the United States, as amended, in effect on December 31, 1965.'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the last line (next to last line in L.D.) the figure "\$75,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$50,000'
