COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 346, L.D. 1212, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for the Registration of Professional Social Workers."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "§4172"

Further amend said Bill by renumbering those sections designated "§4173" and "§4174" to be '§4172' and '§4173'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§4184" by striking out in the 2nd paragraph all of the 2nd underlined sentence and inserting in place thereof the following (same in L.D.):

'A candidate failing any examination may apply for reexamination, which shall be granted upon payment of a fee established by the board in an amount not in excess of the original application fee.'
