AN ACT Regulating Sunday Hunting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2454, amended. Section 2454 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following paragraph:

Notwithstanding any provision of this section, it shall be lawful to hunt small game and wild birds on Sunday state-wide and it shall be lawful to hunt deer, bear and bobcat on Sunday in the Northern Zone.
