IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 15th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follow:

Waldo County: County commissioners, \$1,200; clerk of courts, \$4,700 \$5,700; county attorney, \$5,000; county treasurer, \$7,500 \$1,900; sheriff, \$4,840 \$5,800; register of deeds, \$3,960 \$5,000; judge of probate, \$3,960 \$5,000; register of probate, \$3,960 \$5,000.
