STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to State Appropriation for Local Law Enforcement.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Law Enforcement Planning and Assistance Fund the sum of \$60,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970 and the sum of \$60,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971. These moneys shall be used as matching funds for the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (P. L. 90-351). At least \$30,000 of the state appropriation for each fiscal year shall be used for training local law enforcement officers by the Maine Law Enforcement Council.
