AN ACT Permitting Absentee Voting for Town of Sanford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. & S. L., 1935, c. 72, § 10, amended. Section 10 of chapter 72 of the private and special laws of 1935 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows :

Absentee ballots may be cast at all general and special meetings of registered voters of the town including referendum meetings of such registered voters.
