HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 360, L. D. 1224, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Barber Technicians."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting after the
word "Barber" the words 'Education and'

Further amend said Bill by adding after section 1, a new
section, as follows: (same in L.D.)

'Sec. 1-A. R. S., T. 32, §402, sub-§3-A, amended. Subsection
3-A of section 402 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted
by chapter 287 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as
follows:

3-A. Education. Who has satisfactorily completed a minimum
of 2 years of secondary education or its equivalent, except a
person who because of foreign birth and language difficulties is
not able to pass an equivalency examination but has at least 5
years' experience as a barber shall be excused from the foregoing
educational requirement;
