STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT to Change the Name of Eastern Maine General Hospital to Eastern Maine Medical Center.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Change of name. The organization of Eastern Maine General Hospital as now existing is ratified, confirmed and made valid.

The name Eastern Maine General Hospital is changed to Eastern Maine Medical Center, and all gifts, benefits and devises under either name shall be valid and binding, and the trustees shall have the power to authorize such actions as may be deemed essential in connection with the above provided change of name.

The trustees shall consist of not less than 9 or more than 25 as the corporators shall from time to time determine.
