SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 949, L. D. 1227, Bill, "AN ACT Providing a Bond Issue in the Amount of Two Hundred and Thirteen Thousand Dollars for Construction of Necessary Added Facilities at Camp Waban, York County."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words "Two Hundred and Thirteen Thousand Dollars" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Two Hundred and Ten Thousand Dollars'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the 6th line (5th line in L.D.) the figure "\$213,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$210,000'

Further amend said Bill in section 6 by striking out all of the last 5 lines (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

' 10% Contingency	43,100

42% state share		210,000
Private and federal funds		294,143

		\$ 504,143

Further amend said Bill in the Referendum by striking out all of the question and inserting in place thereof the following question (same in L.D.):

' "Shall a bond issue be ratified for the purposes set forth in 'An Act Providing a Bond Issue in the Amount of Two Hundred and Ten Thousand Dollars for Construction of Necessary Added Facilities at Camp Waban, York County' passed by the 104th Legislature?" '
