## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 104th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "  $_{\rm D}$  " to H. P. 1064, L. D. 1233, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Delivery of Absentee Ballots."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end, a new section, as follows: (same in L. D.):

- 'Sec. 3. R. S., T. 21, §1253, sub-§1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 1253 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 1. Applications available. On request, the clerk shall furnish a reasonable number of ballot applications to any person, except that such ballot applications shall not be furnished earlier than 3 months before any election.'
