HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to H. P. 1064, L. D. 1233, Bill, "AN
ACT Relating to Delivery of Absentee Ballots."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by striking out the words "Delivery
of" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Application for'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 21, §1252, sub-§2, amended. Subsection 2 of section
1252 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the
end the following paragraphs:

There shall be printed on the application and the return envelope in
boldface type 10-point as follows:

VIOLATION OF ANY ABSENTEE VOTING LAW SHALL BE PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF
NOT MORE THAN \$1,000 OR BY IMPRISONMENT FOR MORE THAN 11 MONTHS, OR BY BOTH.
