STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Evidence of Payment of Compensation or Medical Expenses in Civil Actions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 16, § 357, additional. Title 16 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 357, to read as follows:

§ 357. Compensation and medical expenses

The fact that a party has received compensation or has had medical expenses paid by a collateral source may be admitted into evidence solely for the purpose of showing that party's state of mind or motivation.
