COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 958, L. D. 1239, Bill, "AN
ACT Amending the Waterville City Charter."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1967, c. 132, Art. III, §8, amended.
The 6th sentence of section 8 of Article III of chapter 132 of
the private and special laws of 1967 is repealed and the following
enacted in place thereof:
Every ordinance, order and resolution shall be in writing, and
while primary readings may be by title only, unless there is objection
by a council member, the final reading at a council meeting shall
be in full, including, if any, all amendments, before a vote is
taken thereon. Such vote shall be by division unless 2 or more
members request vote by ayes and nays, in which case the ayes and
nays shall be recorded.'
