STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Amending the Waterville City Charter.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1967, c. 132, Art. III, § 8, amended. The 6th sentence of section 8 of Article III of chapter 132 of the private and special laws of 1967 is amended to read as follows:

Every ordinance, order and resolution shall be in writing, and read in full at a council meeting before a vote is taken thereof; and upon every such vote the ayes and nays shall be recorded.

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1967, c. 132, Art. V, § 1, amended. Section 1 of Article V of chapter 132 of the private and special laws of 1967 is amended to read as follows:

To carry out this purpose, there shall be a director of personnel, who shall be, or shall be appointed by, the administrative assistant administrator.

Sec. 3. P. & S. L., 1967, c. 132, Art. IX, § 8, amended. The last sentence of section 8 of Article IX of chapter 132 of the private and special laws of 1967 is repealed as follows:

All absentee ballots, in order to be valid, must be delivered to the eity elerk, before + p.m. on election day.
