COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 959, L. D. 1240, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Referendum Provisions Under Charter of City of Waterville."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 9th and 10th lines
(7th and 8th lines of L. D.) the underlined figure "\$50,000"
and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$100,000'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following
Referendum:

'Referendum; effective date; certificate to Secretary of State.

This Act shall take effect 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature,
only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters
of the City of Waterville at the next regular municipal election.

The city clerk shall prepare the required ballots, on which he
shall reduce the subject matter of this Act to the following
question:

"Shall the Act Relating to Referendum Provisions Under Charter
of City of Waterville, passed by the 104th Legislature, be accepted?"

The voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against
the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same.

This Act shall take effect for all the purposes hereof immediately
upon its acceptance by a majority vote of the legal voters voting at
said election; provided that the total number of votes cast for and
against the acceptance of this Act at said election equaled or exceeded
20% of the total vote for all candidates for Governor in said city

at the next preceding gubernatorial election.

The result of such election shall be declared by the municipal officers of the City of Waterville and due certificate thereof shall be filed by the city clerk with the Secretary of State.'
