STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Referendum Provisions Under Charter of City of Waterville.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1967, c. 132, Art. X, § 1, repealed and replaced. Section 1 of Article X of chapter 132 of the private and special laws of 1967 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Sec. 1. Provision for referendum. The electors shall have power to approve or reject at the polls any order or ordinance passed by the council, except an ordinance authorizing the levy of taxes or ordinances, resolves or orders appropriating \$50,000 or less for a single capital improvement, and all ordinances, resolves or orders authorizing bond issues of \$50,000 or less for capital improvements.
