

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 104th LEGISLATURE

CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 963, L.D. 1243, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Bids for Contractual Services Under the Auburn City Charter."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following (same in L.D.):

'<u>Referendum</u>. This Act shall be submitted for approval or rejection to the qualified voters of the City of Auburn at the next state-wide election prior to January 1, 1970. The vote shall be taken by ballot at said election in answer to the question, "Shall the city council of Auburn confirm all bids for contractual services and equipment in excess of \$500? " which shall be printed on the official ballots, and at said election the voters of said city in favor of accepting this Act shall vote "Yes" and those opposed shall vote "No."

Otherwise said ballot shall be in the form provided by law when a constitutional amendment is submitted to the vote of the people. If a majority of the valid ballots deposited as aforesaid shall favor accepting the same, then this Act shall forthwith take effect as herein provided.

The result of the vote shall be declared by the municipal officers of the City of Auburn and due certificate thereof filed by the city clerk with the Secretary of State.'
