SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 366, L.D. 1248, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 24, the following sections:

'Sec. 24-A. R.S., T. 17, §1301-A, amended. Section 1301-A of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 371 of the public laws of 1969, is amended by inserting after the first paragraph, a new paragraph, as follows:

The inspectors and agents of licensing authorities issuing licenses under this section shall have the authority to investigate and prosecute complaints against its licensees for violation of this section, and to institute proceedings before the Administrative Hearing Commissioner who shall be empowered to proceed under Title 5, chapters 301 to 307, and not under Title 28, section 401.

Sec. 24-B. Effective date. Section 24-A of this Act shall take effect 91 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'
