SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 366, L.D. 1248, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Sec. 55. P. & S.L., 1967, c. 132, Art. II, §6, amended. The first sentence of section 6 of article II of chapter 132 of the private and special laws of 1967 is amended to read as follows: The administrator shall be chosen as provided in subsection VI of section 5, ~~for-an-indefinite-term~~ to serve at the pleasure of the mayor during the term of his office, on the basis of his character, executive and administrative qualifications and experience and his technical knowledge of municipal management.'
