SENATE AMENDMENT "E" to S.P. 366, L.D. 1248, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 24 the following sections:

'Sec. 24-A. R.S., T. 15, §101, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 101 of Title 15 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 279 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

The examination may be conducted at the Augusta State Hospital, Bangor State Hospital, Pineland Hospital and Training Center or at a mental health clinic of, or recommended by, the Department of Mental Health and Corrections, and when conducted at any such facility shall be the responsibility of a psychiatrist or of a licensed psychologist, who may join with him in such examination other psychiatrists or clinical psychologist, as in his opinion are required.

Sec. 24-B. Effective date. Section 24-A of this Act shall become effective 91 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'
