SENATE AMENDMENT "I" to S.P. 366, L.D. 1248, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 24 the following:

'Sec. 24-A. R. S., T. 15, §708, additional. Title 15 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 708, to read as follows:

§708. Preparation of complaints

The clerk shall, in the absence or unavailability of a complaint justice, county attorney or assistant county attorney, prepare and draft complaints upon the request of any law enforcement officer.'
