STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 7th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Kennebec County: County commissioners, \$2,250 \$2,750; chairman, \$2,500 \$3,000; clerk of courts, \$5,250 \$5,750; deputy clerk of courts, \$3,885; county attorney, \$6,500; assistant county attorney, \$4,500; county treasurer, \$4,500; sheriff, \$6,000 \$7,000; register of deeds, \$6,500; judge of probate, \$6,500 \$7,000; register of probate, \$4,000 \$4,500.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1969.
