RESOLVE, Providing Moneys for Cerebral Palsy Clinics for Home Care Programs.

Cerebral Palsy Clinics; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Cerebral Palsy Clinics the sum of \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970 and the sum of \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971 to be used to help support a program of home care on a visiting basis; said sum to be allocated as follows: \$1,000 to the Northeastern Maine Clinic at Bangor; \$1,000 to the Central Clinic at Augusta and \$1,000 to the Portland Clinic at Portland.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Parents of Cerebral Palsy children not in school have a great need for qualified relief to let them shop, rest, receive medical care and the like. Private funds of the clinics have been insufficient to allow more than a very small start on this. This bill will enable them to do more in this vital area.
