STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Use of False or Unauthorized Credit Devices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 1621, amended. Section 1621 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Any person who was properly issued a credit device shall not be liable for charges made through the use of such device after the loss or theft of the credit device, unless a notice is printed in at least 8-point bold type on the device or in writing accompanying the card when issued, and thereafter when such is done liability on the part of the original holder shall continue only until written notice of the loss or theft is sent by registerd mail to the issuer.
